Since, then, you have been raised with Christ,⁶ set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.⁷ ² Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.⁸ ³ For you died,⁴ and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ, who is your⁵ life,⁷ appears,⁷ then you also will appear with him in glory.⁸

⁹ Put to death,⁹ therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature:⁹ sexual immorality,⁹ impurity, lust, evil desires and greed,⁹ which is idolatry.⁹ ¹⁰ Because of these, the wrath of God¹⁰ is coming.¹⁰ ¹¹ You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived.¹¹ ¹² But now you must also rid yourselves¹² of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander,¹² and filthy language¹² from your lips.¹² ¹³ Do not lie to each other,¹³ since you have taken off your old self¹³ with its practices¹³ and have put on the new self,¹³ which is being renewed¹³ in knowledge in the image of its Creator.¹³ ¹⁴ Here there is no Gentile or Jew,¹⁴ circumcised or uncircumcised,¹⁴ barbarian, Scythian, slave or free,¹⁴ but Christ is all,¹⁴ and is in all.

¹⁵ Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves¹⁵ with compassion, kindness, humility,¹⁵ gentleness and patience.¹⁵ ¹⁶ Bear with each other¹⁶ and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.¹⁶ ¹⁷ And over all these virtues put on love,¹⁷ which binds them all together in perfect unity.¹⁷

¹⁸ Let the peace of Christ¹⁸ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body¹⁸ you were called to peace.¹⁸ And be thankful. ¹⁹ Let the message of Christ¹⁹ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom¹⁹ through psalms,¹⁹ hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.¹⁹ ²⁰ And whatever you do,²⁰ whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks²⁰ to God the Father through him.
