
Jesus, 2 Daughters, and Us - John Chambers 8-4-24-1

Jesus is the Trustworthy Savior for These 2 Daughters (and us)

- Only Jesus has the authority over death and disease and is trustworthy to heal us. (v. 29 – The Woman, v. 41 – Jairus)
- 4. 4.) Jesus is our only hope to receive eternal "sozo" (rescued, saved, healed, preserved, restored, made whole) (v. 28, 34 The Woman)
