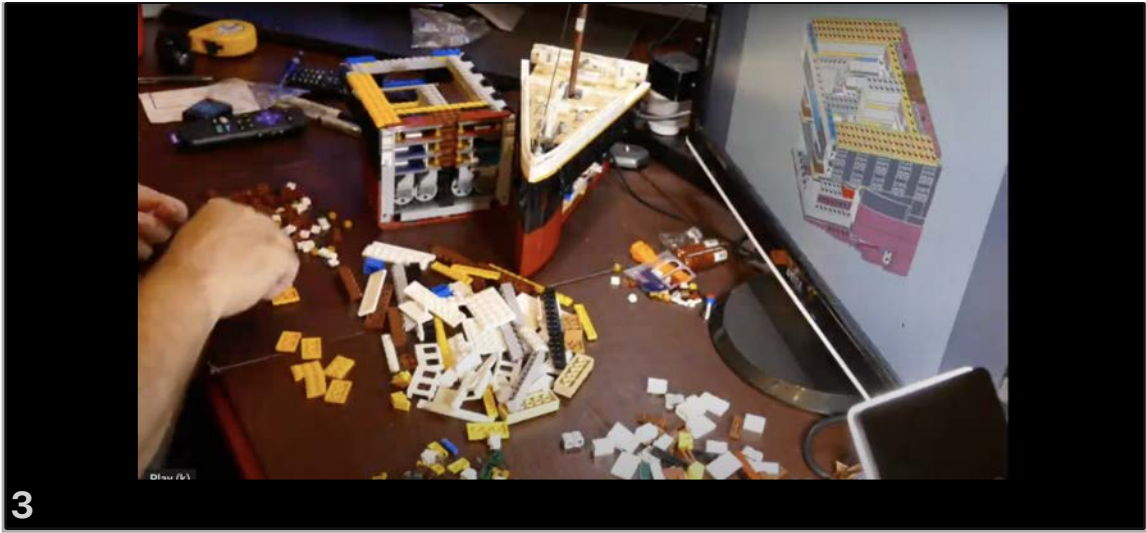

A Christian wife only has one King, Jesus Christ. He is the ultimate authority in her life. The reason that a Christian wife submits to her husband is that it honors Jesus her King who has called her to be a joyful, wise, helpful support to her husband as he seeks to fulfill His leadership role in their family.

But if the husband of a Christian wife seeks to lead his wife to act or speak in a way that displeases or dishonors her heavenly King, his wife should not follow her husband into disobedience.

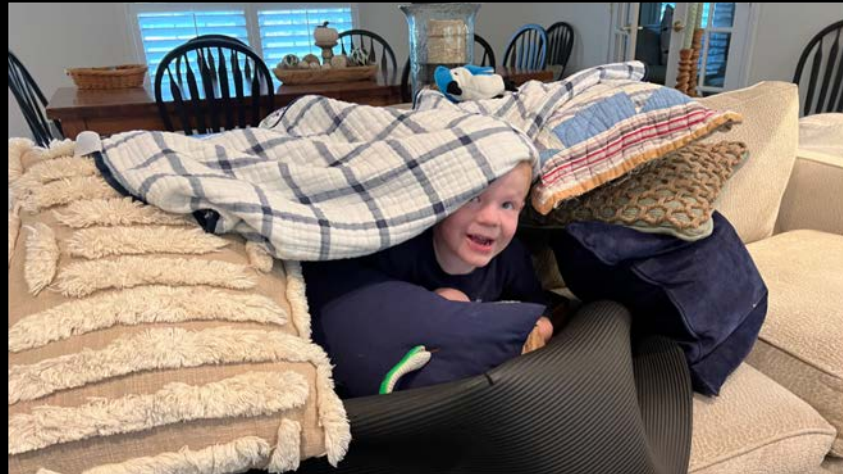
